● 6:10 p.m. – Students report to the track near the scoreboard

● 6:25 p.m. – Students walk the track with their school
After the walk, kindergarten students will report to the goal post near the scoreboard for Meet at the 50, and Middle School & Parks and Rec Football Teams will report to the track near the Field House.

● 6:40 p.m. – **Meet at the 50** (Kindergarten and Senior Fall Athletes, Senior Cheerleaders, and Senior Band Members)

● 6:50 p.m. – Band performs the National Anthem

● 6:55 p.m. – Coin Toss with Football Team Captains

● 7:00 p.m. – Band plays the Fight Song & Football Team Runs Out

Track Walk & Recognition

● At 6:10 p.m., students will line up by school on the track to show their Bearcat pride.

● One adult may accompany each elementary student on the track.

● After the walk, all students (except kindergarten students) will exit with their family to sit in the home bleachers with their school in the designated seating sections to enjoy the game.

● Kindergarten students will move to the goal post near the scoreboard for **Meet at the 50**.

● Middle School Football, Cheer, and Parks & Rec Teams will walk the track, then report to the track area near the Field House at 6:40 p.m. to prepare to run out with the varsity team at 7:00 p.m.

● Middle School Cheerleaders will cheer as the team runs out.

Student Admission & Guidelines

● Elementary Students: Receive one free admission ticket through their school (for the student only).

● Middle School Football Players & Cheerleaders: Admitted free if wearing their jersey or cheer uniform.

● Parks & Recreation Football Players: If enrolled in an Anson County elementary school, they will receive a ticket through their school and may also enter free when wearing their jersey.

!! All students must be accompanied by an adult (21 or older) to enter the stadium. !!
